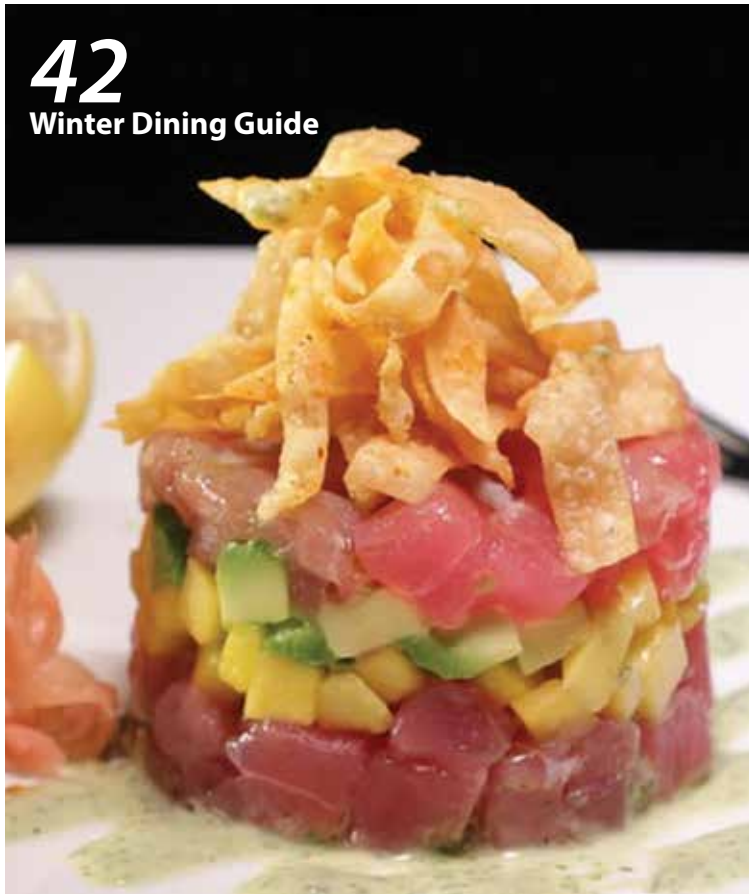

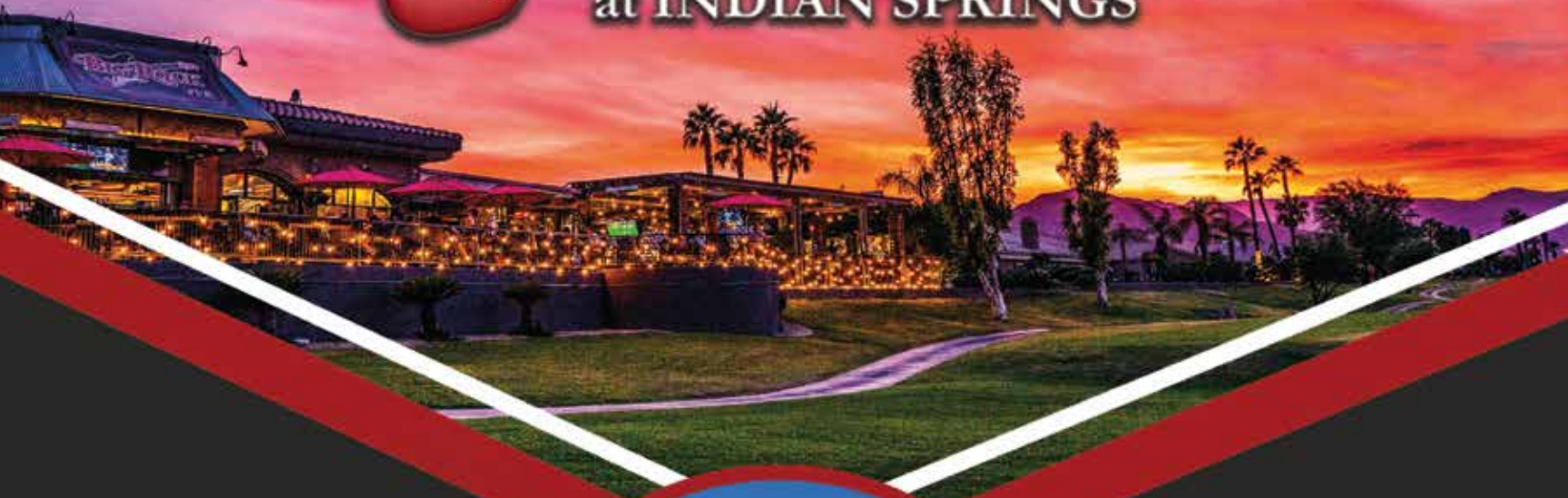




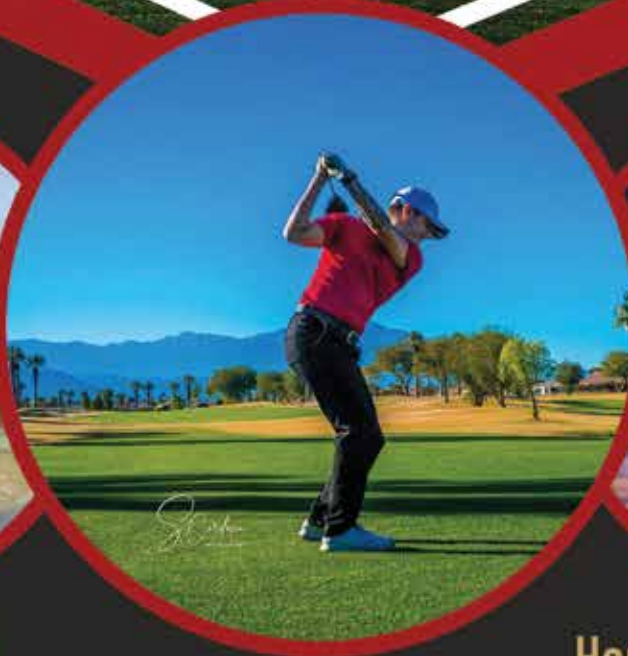

American Express Championship

celebrates 65 years of PGA Tour excellence in La Quinta

It's pretty darned unusual for ANY charity event to say they've surpassed \$65 million in lifetime charitable contributions. However, this is exactly what The American Express – or The AmEx – can boast since its inception in 1960 and on the heels of celebrating another banner year of giving with the \$1 million raised for charity through its 2023 installment for the PGA Tour tournament.

The 65th edition of The American Express will take place January 18-21, 2024 at PGA West's Stadium Course (host course) and Nicklaus Tournament Course and La Quinta Country Club. The AmEx annually tees up the start of the PGA Tour's west coast swing and is the Tour's first 2024 regular season event in the U.S., showcasing 156 professional golfers and 156 amateurs.

Fans and players can expect exceptional golf, unforgettable hospitality experiences and show-stopping entertainment. As if the top-tier golf isn't enough, this year's concert entertainment following play on Friday and Saturday evenings will see Keith Urban and Train take the stage. Both concerts will take place on the PGA West Stadium Course driving range.

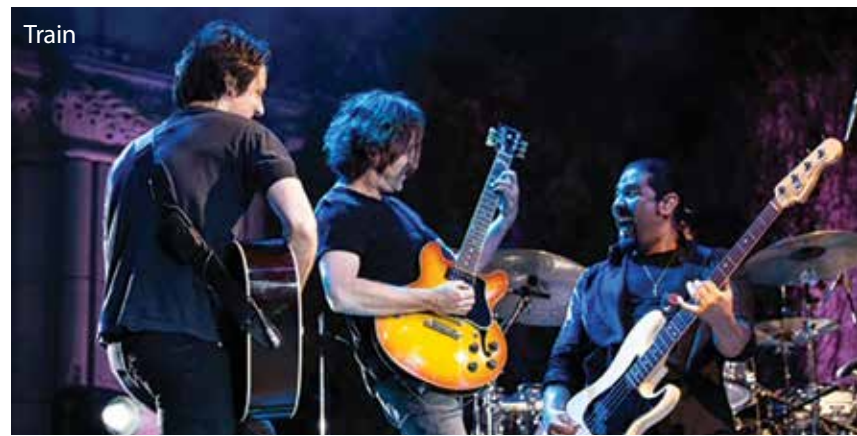
Urban is a four-time Grammy Award-winning musician with nine consecutive gold, platinum or multi-platinum albums and scores of CMA, American Country Music (ACM), American Music Awards (AMAs) and People's Choice Awards.

Train, fronted by Pat Monahan, has had 14 songs on Billboard's Hot 100, 13 albums on the Billboard 200 chart, and has sold more than 10 million albums and 30 million tracks worldwide.

The global hitmakers have earned multiple gold, platinum, and diamond-certified records as well as three Grammy Awards and two Billboard Music Awards.

Pat McCabe, executive director of The American Express since 2018, is quick to give credit to title sponsor American Express for transforming the event into a cultural phenomenon since signing on in 2020. McCabe says, "Giving back is at the heart of what the tournament is about. We know American Express to be a global leader in the payment industry, but what's amazing is that they still place focus on the local community."

And do they ever. The tournament is estimated by some to have generated around \$300 million for the Coachella Valley since 2020.

McCabe is excited to see The AmEx coincide with the 65th anniversary of PGA Tour golf in La Quinta in 2024. His company, Sportfive, also represents last year's The American Express winner, Jon Rahm, through the player management division of the company. Rahm, a Spaniard, went on to secure the green jacket in April at the Masters. His victory in The American Express in 2023 marked his third consecutive worldwide win, with a final round 68 on the PGA West Stadium Course and an overall score of 27-under-par 261.

McCabe notes that final player commitments aren't determined until the week prior to the event. McCabe will be watching along with fans to see if Rahm will defend his title, having won the 2023 event by one shot over Davis Thompson, who carded a 69 in the final round. Last year's tournament showcased four of the top six players in the Official World Golf Ranking.

Daily grounds tickets begin at \$60 for access to Thursday's first round on January 18, and final round tickets on Sunday, January 21 are \$75. Admission on Friday and Saturday, January 19 and 20, is \$85 and includes the post-round concert each day.

For the most deluxe experience, fans can visit the private Champions Club, located around the 18th green of the Stadium Course. It includes a preferred parking pass and features a climate-controlled tent and open-air deck with hosted breakfast and lunch, snacks and a full bar all day. Daily tickets are \$375-\$475. Champions

Club members holding tickets to Friday's and Saturday's concert days get in on access to an upgraded VIP viewing area near the stage with a complimentary full bar.

The Dye Club is another premium hospitality venue which provides access to its open-air venue along the Stadium Course's signature par-3 17th hole, known as Alcatraz. Those ticket holders receive complimentary lunch and hosted beer and wine inside the Dye Club. Daily tickets are \$225-\$300, with concert admission included on Friday and Saturday.

Other refreshment stations and public venues at PGA West's Stadium Course include The Turn, Casamigos Fan Deck (at the 18th fairway), Michelob Ultra Beers For Birdies (at the Alcatraz hole offering beer discounts any time a pro makes a birdie on the hole), Bushmills Whiskey Lounge and Corona Premier Par-Tee Lounge.

All charitable donations from the tournament are distributed to local nonprofit organizations dedicated to health and wellness, youth sports, family support, education and homelessness. This past cycle, beneficiaries included Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Desert; Boys & Girls Club of Coachella Valley; Family YMCA of the Desert; FIND (Food In Need of Distribution) Food Bank Coachella Valley; Galilee Center; Jewish Family Service of the Desert; Martha's Village and Kitchen; and others.

McCabe said, "Attending The American Express is a sporting tradition of the Coachella Valley. It is one of the PGA Tour's most storied golf tournaments, and it continues to rise in stature through the enhancement of our overall, elevated fan experience. Our field of professional golfers has improved with each passing year, and the 2023 event hosted our best player field in recent memory. Patrons can also take heart in supporting a community event that has raised more than \$65 million in local charitable funding."

2023 Nitto ATP Finals: Djokovic Dominates Yet Again

On Nov. 19, 2023, Novak Djokovic made history—once again, proving that his reign as tennis’s number one ranked male star is likely going to continue well into 2024.

While winning his record seventh Nitto ATP Finals, Djokovic capped off one of his greatest seasons yet. Not only did he claim seven titles in 2023, along with a 55-6 win-loss record, but he also won three of the four majors: the Australian Open, the French Open and the US Open. And he contended against a rising star, Carlos Alcaraz, who defeated him in the finals at Wimbledon.

As a further sign of his dominance, he has attained 98 singles titles thus far in his career. In addition, he’s been ranked number one for 400 weeks, 90 weeks more than Roger Federer, who is in second place on the all-time list.

Upon reflection of each of these dominating statistics, including the fact that he’s won 24 Grand Slam singles titles (two more than Rafael Nadal, who is in second place), Djokovic’s future can be viewed in one of two ways. First, one could argue that he should retire while on top, having achieved nearly every key record he could on the ATP Tour. However, at the same time, one could also argue that

his career is far from complete, as he may be able to break even more records in the future.

Djokovic clearly agrees with the second argument.

“I have the highest ambitions and goals. That’s not going to be different for next year, that’s for sure,” he said. “The drive that I have is still there.”

Adding that he could “win four Slams and Olympic gold” in 2024, he stressed that his “motivation is still present”, with regards to Grand Slams, ATP Finals and the Olympic Games. In fact, one of his major goals for next season is to win the Olympics, despite how difficult the 2024 season schedule will be at times.

“It’s going to be [a] very congested schedule, with going from the slowest to the fastest surface in sport back to the slowest—clay, grass, clay, then hard court,” he emphasized. “Obviously, that’s a very demanding, challenging stretch of the year.”

Not to mention, he’ll also likely have to defeat the ATP Tour’s “Young Gen” in the

midst of the challenging 2024 schedule too: from Carlos Alcaraz and Daniil Medvedev, to Jannik Sinner, Stefanos Tsitsipas and Alexander Zverev. As evidenced by his record at the 2023 Nitto ATP Finals, he should be able to rise to the occasion though.

After all, he defeated Alcaraz 6-3, 6-2 during the semifinals on Saturday, Nov. 18, prior to defeating Sinner 6-3, 6-3 a few hours later.

“Being able to compete with the young guys is always extra motivation for me,” Djokovic said. “I know they are hungry and have big goals to win these kinds of tournaments. So, that inspires me even more to play my best tennis.”

While playing in his home country of Italy at Pala Alpitour, 22-year-old Sinner felt positive overall, despite his loss to Djokovic.

“I think there are many positive things, to be honest,” he stated. “I think, especially [during] the second half of the year, mentally I was much, much stronger.”

He continued, “I played many important matches in the biggest matches—in the biggest stadiums—we have throughout the whole year, [which] is something [that can] hopefully help [me] for the next season.”

As Sinner prepares for the 2024 season, he has been inspired by Djokovic, particularly after competing against him at the 2023 Nitto ATP Finals.

“[Novak] makes me a better player,” he said. “He is an inspiration because he worked throughout the whole years before, when he was younger, in the right way to get to this point. That’s also one of my goals.”

While reflecting on his record-breaking performance, Djokovic was not only contemplative about his remarkable 2023 season, but complementary of his younger contemporary, too.

“[It was] one of the best seasons I’ve had in my life, no doubt,” he stressed. “To crown it with a win against a hometown hero, Jannik, who has played amazing tennis this week, is phenomenal.”

Although Djokovic is preparing to continuously break records, he also fully understands that tennis’s future lies in the hands of the “Young Gen”, as proven in his comments after winning the 2023 Nitto ATP Finals.

“I’m very proud of [my] performances these last two days against Alcaraz and Sinner, probably the best two players in the world next to me and Medvedev at the moment,” he said. “And [given] the way they have been playing, I had to step it up. I had to win the matches and not wait for them to hand me the victory. And that’s what I’ve done.”

If the 2023 Nitto ATP Finals offers any evidence of what’s to come, the 2024 ATP Tour season may ultimately be remembered as one of the best yet, as Djokovic continues to prove that age is just a number—all while stepping up to the challenges of the sport’s future stars, each of whom have been inspired by his record-breaking career.

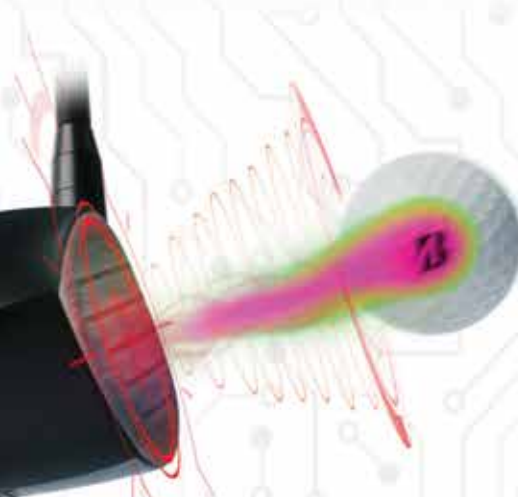

Desert Smash

Takes over La Quinta with a collision of Hollywood, live music and pro tennis



The unofficial kick-off to the BNP Paribas showcases the ultimate lifestyle and pop culture event



The course of culture and history is altered each time worlds collide, sociologically speaking. A powerful case in point: Desert Smash, which brilliantly combines Hollywood, music and professional tennis for charity.

Celebrating its 20th anniversary on March 4-5, 2024, Desert Smash has come to be known as the foremost event in the world that fuses these potent forces for charity, founded by Epic Sports and now produced by Brand Innovators. As Epic Sports and Desert Smash founder Ryan Macaulay says, "This event is a result of celebrities and players putting their egos aside and coming together for the greater good."

The production brings together Hollywood's biggest celebrities and some of the world's best pro tennis players for an extravaganza at the prestigious La Quinta Resort & Club in La Quinta, California. The event is intentionally held immediately prior to the 5th

largest tennis tournament in the world, the BNP Paribas Open, in neighboring Indian Wells.

The Tuesday, March 5 afternoon event takes place at the resort's Stadium tennis court with fan options ranging from VIP on-court seating to live ball playing experiences. DJs fill the air with musical vibes, and the festive atmosphere is complemented by a fun "Desert Smash Village" of brands and sponsors showcasing products, celebrities walking the red carpet and margaritas flowing at multiple premium-hosted bars.

The 2024 event will introduce a pickle-ball component on Monday, March 4. Attendees will be able to watch celebs and pros compete against each other with the same jovial esprit de corps.

Macaulay — sports executive, savvy businessperson, innovator, entrepreneur and event producer — came up with the idea for Desert Smash during his time working for Adidas where he oversaw the tennis category. A Cape Cod, Massachusetts native, Macaulay grew up and spent summers on the tennis courts of the local resort, forging a friendship with former pro tennis player and coach Tim Gullikson. When Gullikson, his mentor, passed from a brain tumor, Macaulay was determined to give something back. And so, The Adidas Tennis Smash was born. After several years of resounding success on Cape Cod and later in Newport with the beneficiary being the Tim & Tom Gullikson Foundation, Macaulay — after a move to LA - brought the event to the Coachella Valley and re-imagined it to include A-list Hollywood performers, comedians and actors in addition to top-seeded pro tennis players. That first event in 2003 included a young player named Novak Djokovic, just starting his career, who is of course now the ATP No. 1 in singles in the world and all-time leader in career grand slams.

Other players that first year included Maria Sharapova and the Bryan brothers with celebrity participants such as Joe Pesci, Gavin Rossdale and Lance Bass. Since then, the number of players and celebrities has exploded year after year, with notable participants



having included Serena Williams, Pink, Will Ferrell, Justin Bieber, Kevin Hart, Frances Tiafoe, Victoria Azarenka, Hyeon Chung, Lisa Leslie, Wanda Sykes, Donna Mills, Randy Jackson, Nicole Ari Parker, Boris Kodjoe, Joel McHale, Kevin Spacey, Rebel Wilson, Jon Hamm...and the list goes on.

Macaulay's dream was to hold the event at the famed La Quinta Resort & Club, capturing the pillars of Hollywood history, laid-back desert lifestyle and scenic aesthetic that represents a sophisticated quality of life, along with its beautiful sunken stadium overlooking the Santa Rosa Mountains. He purposely scheduled the event for the Tuesday before the BNP Paribas Open for more favorable room rates. After some negotiating, the La Quinta Resort graciously agreed to collaborate and partner on the event, and they are now aligned every step of the way as the world-class hospitality partner and sponsor of Desert Smash (laquintaresort.com).

The first year, proceeds benefited the Tim and Tom Gullikson Foundation which funds programs to help brain tumor patients and their families with the physical, emotional and social challenges presented for those affected.

Along the way, Macaulay and his Brand Innovators partner and colleague Andrew Sokolsky started incorporating live performances into the event. When Gavin Rossdale approached Macaulay and asked, "don't you want me to jam?", Macaulay realized this was a "pinch-me" moment that could take the event to an entirely different level, with a mind-blowing intimate acoustic set performed that year by Rossdale. Since that pivot, other musical performers have included Justin Bieber, Lifehouse, Sia, Natasha Bedingfield, JaRule, DJ Bob Sinclar, Nelly, Boyz II Men and Robin Thicke in 2023.

Every year or two, Desert Smash rotates the beneficiary, having raised a whopping \$3.6 million during the past 20 years. Recipient charities have included Cancer for College, Variety the Children's Charity, Sophie's Voice Foundation, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, Yetunde Price Resource Center and Playing for Change Foundation, among others.

Macaulay emphasizes that the effort has been a labor of love with local sponsors such as Marker Broadcasting, Gulf Broadcasting and KESQ. Each year, Desert Smash attracts media coverage from not only sports outlets but also from music, lifestyle, cultural and

entertainment leaders including Entertainment Tonight, Access Hollywood, Hollywood Reporter, Vogue, Vanity Fair and scores of others, with 2023 media impressions exceeding 22 billion worldwide.

The event features a live auction, with highly sought-after items up for bid such as traveling with the LA Rams on their private team plane, VIP seating in the BNP Paribas players' box and a stay at an exclusive private home with three days of Masters' passes. One of the live auction moments during the exhibition is the chance to be seated next to the celebrity guest umpire. During the 2023 event, Pink generously auctioned a fan package for one of her live concerts. Midway through the auction, she doubled down and spontaneously added a second package for \$15K on the spot.

Each year is marked by impromptu moments of hilarity as well as generosity. One year, Will Farrell autographed cowbells for proceeds. For founder Macaulay, a warm association that stands out is the connection he has seen develop between Pink and player Frances Tiafoe, a rare alignment of parallel energy and interests brought about only through the magic of Desert Smash.

After a full day of play both on and off the court, the celebrities, players and sponsors are treated in the evening to the exclusive "Desert Smash Bash", the afterparty of all afterparties. Last year, the Bash was hosted at Zenyara, the 75-acre, ultra-luxury mega-private estate in Coachella donated to Desert Smash by billionaire owner and philanthropist Michael Scott.

Macaulay says, "The Desert Smash is about fun, goodwill and charity. It's about getting together an interesting group of people, providing great entertainment and adding something positive to the community."

Turning your body/Hips

Happy Golf Holiday Feels. Today we are going to focus on your TURN. I have 3 photo examples of "TURNING YOUR BODY / HIPS". Turn can help or make your swing or golf ball go in very "FAR" & improve your "DISTANCE". I feel adding an amazing TURN to your golf swing is a huge key for your distance SUCCESS



TURN DRILLS - set up

1. Objects needed = 1 golf club, bungee cord (to go around your waist), & pool noodle

2. Set up: Put bungee cord around your waist, put pool noodle around the waist area for a "VISUAL OR FEELS"

TURN DRILLS

1. TURN YOUR BODY (depends on your physical needs or injuries)... turn your knees or hips toward the back (45* or pointing at your back toe)

2. The HIPS TURN IN A LEVEL MANNER (if you are able), they go around your spine (NOT up & down)

3. Turn to both the back & front (the takeaway & follow through)

4. As a "TURN STRETCH", hold each side for 3,5,10 seconds or 1 minute depending on your feels or needs or what your body can or cannot do, stay with in listening to your body's needs



TURN DRILLS - (super advanced)

1. TURN YOUR BODY & hit golf balls with something on your waist (pool noodle or shorter alignment rod)

2. If hitting golf balls, (for the first time) try 1/3 swing to ... swing & small speed or you can injure yourself (not for the beginner golfer) — practice at your own risk or see a golf pro to do it correctly

I look forward to helping you with your TURN. Let's work on your TURN today. Hopefully this simple TURN DRILL / STRETCH helps you feel a better golf game. Happy golfing feels, seeing you on the golf course.
